The Jackson Medical Mall / CNA Training Center is now offering a 3-week certification course to become a Medical Phlebotomist.

What is a Medical Phlebotomist? Simply, a healthcare professional worker who draws blood and ensures the proper amount is taken and that all blood is properly labeled. The blood could possibly be used for tests, transfusions, research, blood donations, etc.

The Department of Labor's Job Outlook States: Employment of phlebotomists is projected to grow 25 percent from 2014 to 2024, much faster than the average for all occupations. Hospitals, diagnostic laboratories, blood donor centers, and other locations will need phlebotomists to perform bloodwork. The median pay in 2015 was \$31,630.
